




Black Genius Academy End-of-Year Report



A Letter from the Career Karma CEO and Google's Tech Equity Collective Lead

As we reflect on the past year, it feels like only yesterday when we were envisioning a movement to increase the representation of Black professionals in the tech industry. And when our collaboration began, our shared belief that we could make a real and tangible impact became a reality.

In the span of a year, our teams have worked tirelessly to create something unique and impactful for the Black community that the world has never seen before. The response we've witnessed in the first four months from our learners and the <u>public has been nothing short of incredible, and we take great pride</u> in the collective work we have achieved.

The numbers speak for themselves—1,367 learners have begun their journey to start their tech careers, 157 invitations have been distributed to BGA learners, and 38 individuals have received full-tuition grants for bootcamp programs. This is more than progress; it's the embodiment of real change.

As we look ahead to the new year, we are excited about the possibilities that lie ahead not only for Career Karma and Google but also for the other companies and organizations that are part of or decide to become a part of the Tech Equity Collective initiative.

Although our journey has just begun, we hold on to the dream of the continued potential of Black Genius Academy, now empowered by our dynamic community. Together, we believe we can change the lives of thousands of aspiring Black innovators and leave a lasting impact on the tech industry.

Executive Summary

What Is Black Genius Academy?

Black Genius Academy (BGA) is a career navigation web-based app developed by Career Karma, Inc., in collaboration with Tech Equity Collective, a Google initiative. This effort was driven by a shared vision to introduce aspiring Black innovators and technologists to high-demand tech fields, namely, cybersecurity, software engineering, and product design.

What Does Black Genius Academy Offer?

Members of the Black Genius Academy community gain full access to the following at no cost:



Career Navigation Roadmap

An 8-step action plan featuring 20 interviews with seasoned tech professionals and 61 lessons to guide learners in choosing their desired tech roles and skills training path.

Notable guests include Aston Motes, known as the first employee at Dropbox; Crystal Moore, the Vice President of Brilliant Black Minds; Jason Mayden, the Founder of Trillicon Valley; and Rich Smith, a Senior Software Engineer at Netflix.



Personal Career Navigation Coaching

A tailored one-on-one and group career coaching experience to guide users in creating a strategic approach to skills development and career growth.



Discord Community

A supportive community designed to foster inclusivity, connections, and knowledge-sharing



Skills Training Grants

Eligible users may apply for a limited number of fulltuition grants with partner bootcamps or Grow with Google scholarships in Cybersecurity and UX Design.


Learner Distribution

Learners by Tech Role

In Step 2 of the Action Plan, learners listen to informational interviews with professionals in software engineering, cybersecurity, and UX design. By the end of this step, learners select the career path that best aligns with their interests and skills.

Among BGA learners, cybersecurity has been the top choice, while UX design has been selected the least.







Learners by Tech Role

Once learners reach Step 6 of their Action Plan, they can select their preferred learning path. Those who prefer to learn on their own can choose from various programs, including Grow with Google, App Academy Open, and freeCodeCamp. On the other hand, those who opt for a bootcamp route may apply for full-tuition grants through App Academy or Hackbright Academy. They can also schedule a call with their BGA coach to explore other bootcamp or self-guided options.

Community Engagement

The BGA community involves different avenues for guidance and participation: coaching calls, Discord, and live events.

We facilitate three distinct types of group coaching calls within the Black Genius Academy. In total, 204 calls have been made across these three sessions, with attendance averaging around 18 learners per call.

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Sessions booked

For a more personalized career navigation coaching experience, BGA learners may also schedule 1-on-1 calls with their BGA coach. Over the last four months, learners have scheduled more than 400 1-on-1 coaching sessions, resulting in over 12,000 minutes of career guidance conversations.

Messages sent

Learners also have the option to submit questions through the platform's in-app messaging channel. Notably, our records indicate 6,733 messages sent by the coaching team to learners to date. This underscores the active engagement and dynamic interaction within our learning community.

In addition to providing BGA learners with invaluable resources and insights through their action plans, our vision extended to cultivating an inclusive space for our learners. Within a mere four months, our Discord community has grown to 1,374 members, witnessing organic initiatives as members autonomously created events—ranging from celebrating their wins to fostering accountability on their collective journey through the tech industry.

Discord has seamlessly facilitated our communication with the community, making it easy to disseminate information about various tech-related events. In October 2023 alone, a cohort of BGA learners joined AfroTech, a testament to our community's active engagement and eagerness to broaden their horizons in the industry.

Discord community | Live Events

Every week, we invite tech industry professionals to share insider tips and insights on various aspects of the tech landscape. Our topics include career change strategies, job search tips, firsthand bootcamp experiences, and guidance on community and network building.

Since September 1, we have successfully hosted a total of 13 Ask Me Anything (AMA) sessions.

All live events are recorded, providing learners the flexibility to view these sessions asynchronously at their convenience on the Black Genius Academy platform.
